## F. NON-ACTION INFORMATION ITEMS/REPORTS/PRESENTATIONS/AWARDS

- 1. Leadership: Mrs. Kassi Kee Sissy Luttrell, Natalie Haggard and Lily Sundby gave an update on Leadership activities. Middle School Dance is Friday, October 21, 2022; we'll have a Haunted Hallway, paint pumpkins and face painting. Leadership has opened a student store for Middle School students on Tuesdays for 6th grade, Wednesdays for 7th grade and Thursdays for 8th grade. Middle School students can trade in Terrific Tigers for snacks, drinks, baseball cards, etc. We are using Code & Learn Financial Literacy and Java to code and make games.
- 2. Enrollment Update: Mrs. Lindsay Rhoades- Enrollment was 480 at the end of October.
- 3. Financial Update: Mrs. Becky Whitaker Finance Committee Meeting is December 6, 2022 at 10AM to review First Interim Budget Adjustments. Family Movie Night was a PTO Fundraising event. Certain school groups fundraised amounts directly to the school as follows: 5th grade soda sales generated over \$800 to be used towards field trips (Camp Sea Lab this year and Shady Creek next year). All sodas were donated by families; 4th grade sold glow sticks and generated around \$350 to be used towards field trips (Coloma an overnight field trip); Leadership sold popcorn and candy to help pay for the dances, rallies and assemblies and generated around \$370 and Sunshine Club sold pizza and generated around \$200 for staff support while filling a need for a lower cost dinner option for families. Audit adjustments are still being sent over and will be presented in December. ESSER III adjustments made to match actuals to a greater extent. Redline and revised version are attached.
