  - 1. Enrollment: Mrs. Lindsay Rhoades- Ended the school year with 454 students.
  - 2. Financial Report: Mrs. Becky Whitaker
  - 3. Superintendent/Principal Report: Dr. Karen Villalobos
  - 4. Data & Assessment: Mr. Obie Leff- State Testing Completion Percentages, NWEA is a local test for grades K-2<sup>nd</sup> with a 99.2% completion rate; CAASPP is a state test, which we do not have the results back yet for grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> with a 99% completion rate; CAST Science is for grades 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> to complete after the CAASPP with a 95.2 percentage rate; Summative ELPAC is a 100% completed, this will allow us to hopefully reclassify students who have reached proficient. Beginning fall 2021 students in grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> will take the NWEA Map Science, which is aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS). Students will receive overall and instructional area scores to support learning.
  - Gradebooks and report cards moving to Aeries Standard-based grading in the fall. This will allow alignment between gradebooks, Parent Portal and report cards. Each grade level report card will be customed created.
  - 5. Safety Update: Mrs. Christina Jolly- Key Progress Indicators (KPI), we love looking at academic progress, we are also fostering children who are college career community ready and that is more than just academics. Make sure they are behavioral meeting our expectations as well as their mental health and social emotional capacity. You're going to see a lot of N/A's for 2020/21 and we found that there is a lot of things we can't replicate in distance learning. This summer will give the counseling staff and PBIS team time to look at what data we want to collect. The data we have collected in the past is Student Engagement, Social Emotional Survey, Discipline, Physical Fitness Tests and Survey data.
  - 6. Special Education: Ms. Kari Hudson- Snapshot for the 2020/21 school year, which includes caseload and primary eligibility. This is our second year with the blended program and reading levels have increased (closing the gasps), we have been able to push a few students back out to general education during this year with COVID.
