 - 4. Data & Assessment: Mr. Obie Leff- State Testing has been completed, normally we would have all of the results in a public setting. We do have the preliminary results student by student and we've been putting together a study of those to look at the overall performance in English Language Arts and Math, subgroup performance and individual students. Our intention is for teachers to go over their results individually and then come together to study trends and then use the results to help support students. Unfortunately, I can't discuss the results in a public setting because the testing session was extended for 2021 through July 30, 2021. Assessment Handbook has been updated and shared, anything in blue and underlined is a link in our google drive. Any resource is clickable to more specific information. Update on standards based grading, a shift in the way we're going to report student learning in grades Kindergarten through Sixth grade. We used to look at grades by points; go through a grading scale to see how the students did. With the standard based grading the teacher teams will determine for each learning target/ or standard what does proficiency look like, what is our learning goal and what does mastery look like.
