 - Enrollment Update: Mrs. Lindsay Rhoades- Enrollment for the end of July was 497 students. The first day of school, August 9,2023 enrollment was 496 with ADA at 98.99%
 - 2. Financial Update: Mrs. Becky Whitaker
 - 3. Director/Principal Reports: Chrissy Jolly & Obie Leff- Midyear LCAP this year. SB765 will allow CalSTRS retirees to return to work without risking retirement benefits, if they earn more than the cap. The California Department of Education will adopt a screener for dyslexia for grades Kindergarten through second grade by 2024. Twin Rivers Charter School will provide Yuba City Unified School District with a Student Achievement Plan for the 5 year term of the renewed Charter as demonstrated in the annual LCAP. The plan includes Student Learning Goals, Instructional Materials, Local Assessments, Monitoring Student Progress and Data Reporting. TRCS will offer four days of Expanded Learning Opportunities (ELO) during our October Break and four days during our February break. Capturing Kids Hearts offers a program called LeadWorthy that our Middle School students will be using during their Advocacy period. It will focus on Leadership Skills, Personal Responsibility, Social Skills, Consequences of Choices, Resisting Peer Pressure, Healthy Relationships, Conflict Resolution and Peer Mediation, Public Speaking and Goal-Setting.
